Al DeLuca Memorial Trophy for Best Slipper grown by a Hobbyist

Chosen from entries in Classes 032A through 041 Judged by the Paphiopedilum Alliance team

ONLY Hobbyist exhibitors eligible for Trophy. (Commercial exhibitors may receive Rosette in Slipper classes and are eligible for Best in Show from their entries in this Group)

Connecticut Orchid Society Trophy for Best Orchid Grown in the Home

Species or hybrids grown in the home by a Hobbyist or Commercial exhibitor are eligible.

Plants must be entered in judging class 024, 044, 059, 082, 099, 112, 129, 137 or 156

Nominations from All team captains

Connecticut Orchid Society Trophy for Best Species Originating in South or Central America

Species grown by a Hobbyist or Commercial exhibitor where the species' originating/natural habitat is in either South and/or Central America are eligible. Plants must be entered in judging class 161.

Awarded by the judges assigned to judge class 161 for the purposes of awarding this trophy.

Connecticut Orchid Society Trophy for Best Specimen – (large or small)

Specimen Plants from all flower classes grown by a Hobbyist or Commercial exhibitor are eligible.

Entries from all species classes grown by a Hobbyist or Commercial exhibitor are eligible.

Nominations from All team captains

Connecticut Orchid Society Trophy for Best in Show

All flower classes, any alliances grown by a Hobbyist or Commercial exhibitor are eligible.

Rosettes

Rosettes may be awarded in all Alliances – Cattleya, Paphiopedilum, Vandaceous, Phalaenopsis and Doritis, Oncidium, Cymbidium, Dendrobium, Pleurothallid, Miscellaneous Genera, and Art Exhibits.
