NOTE: Doritis is not mentioned in the classifications. Wherever specified, Phalaenopsis includes Doritis. Any plant labelled with a hybrid genus name of Doritaenopsis is considered a pure Phalaenopsis hybrid.

Definition: Standard – flower size > 3” across; usually tall arched inflorescence, w/ large leaf span

Definition: Small/Miniature - flower size 3” or less across; often, but not necessarily, on branching spikes

Definition: HARLEQUIN – Flowers with intensely colored **IRREGULAR** or **ASYMETRICAL** spots/splotches (Taiwan type) or brush marks (painted type)

PELORIC – petals resemble lips; plant has three (3) lips.

BIG LIP – the lip is flat resembling a ‘normal’ petal
